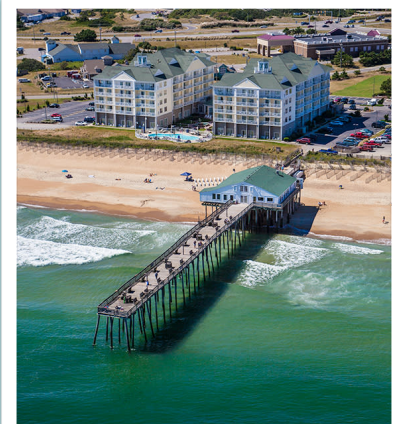

Terms & Conditions

1. **Statement of Purposes:** program is for scientific and educational purposes only and will not promote the company's products, directly or indirectly.

2. **Control of Content & Selection of Presenters & Moderators:** sponsor is ultimately responsible for control of content and selection of presenters and moderators.
